Research Purpose

Our aim is to explore how accurately parents and epileptologists can classify seizure types and non-seizure events. We are seeking parents who are willing to submit home videos of their child experiencing seizures or seizure-mimicking events.

Who Can Participate

Parents of children who meet the following inclusion criteria:

- Ages between 3 months and 35 years old
- Confirmed genetic diagnosis of one of the rare epilepsy syndromes: SYNGAP, CDKL5, Rett Syndrome, CACNA1A, STXBP1, KCNQ2
- Has smart phone video recordings of one or more events, ideally accompanied by a video EEG recording of the same event
